Grade 1 to 6 tests



Learners will write multiple choice tests only. They will sit for a single paper per day according to the time table shown below. Teachers will advise you on the time each paper should be turned in for marking and all pupils are expected to adhere to due dates and time. If for any reason a child is unable to meet the deadline, parents are implored to communicate with the teacher. For easier administration of the examinations, all Content subjects were compressed into a single paper which we named General Paper.

Grade 7 Tests

Parents are requested to collect question papers from the school beginning on Wednesday the 26th of August. We expect all papers to be brought back to the school for marking by Monday 7 September. Parents will collect a set of all the question papers at once but will be expected to release to candidates only the papers to be written on a particular day. You will also receive a Grade Seven answer sheet which you will be expected to photocopy at least 10 copies. To minimise the risk of cheating, parents are urged to let learners take the tests under their watch or that of any responsible adult. Help us have a credible assessment of our students' performance. Teachers will provide further instructions to learners on how to answer the questions.

Development Levy


I thank you for heeding the call to pay Development Levy. I exhort the few who are yet to respond to pay and help us maintain the high standards you have always known the school for.
